Bringing together the combined talents of three of Ontario's best songwriters, Girls with Glasses performances are hilarious, poignant, provocative, and, most of all, fantastic fun!

EVE GOLDBERG. Imagine a kitchen party where Mother Maybelle Carter, Ella Fitzgerald, Mississippi John Hurt, Bessie Smith, Bob Dylan, The Beatles, and Patsy Cline show up, and you begin to get a sense of what it feels like inside Eve Goldberg's head. EVALYN PARRY. Gifted with a sharp pen, a quirky musical sensibility and a wicked sense of humour, Evalyn Parry is taking her place as one of Canada's most powerful and diverse stage artists.
