Riverside Celtic College was conceived by **Eva McCauley** and born in September of 2003 (as the Elora School of Traditional Music). Since its inception there have been hundreds of students enrolled in fiddle, violin, harp, mandolin, tinwhistle, bodhran, bouzouki, guitar, Irish/Scottish Songs, keyboard accompaniment, bagpipes, tune-Learning and session repertoire, the Gaelic Languages and Ceili Dancing. The College also offers workshops, hosts a number of traditional music sessions in the area, and also supports the many C eil is (Irish dances) that are held in and around the region.
