Dave Gunning has been acclaimed as one of Canada's best up-and-coming singer-songwriters. A charismatic performer, Dave is known for infusing his shows with humorous tales and touching commentary on the everyday. Dave's solo releases demonstrate his solid songwriting ability, smooth vocals and acoustic guitar.

Dave was recently nominated for **five more East Coast Music Awards: Fan's Choice Entertainer of the Year, Folk Recording of the Year, Male Solo Recording of the Year, Roots/Traditional Recording of the Year and Producer of the Year.** Even more outstanding is that they honour not one, but **two**

new Dave Gunning recordings: ***We're All Leaving*** and ***a tribute to John Allan Cameron***. On *We're All Leaving*, James Keelaghan, David Francey, Matt Andersen and Karine Polwart are among the co-writers who've helped to make every track a well-polished vignette.

Dave's previous album, *House for Sale* (2007) featured co-writes and duets with Canadian country singer, George Canyon and Newfoundland's songsmith, Ron Hynes. The album won two East Coast Music Awards for **Male Artist of the Year** and **Folk Recording of the Year**. Dave's song, "*Hard Workin' Hands*" (co-written with Hynes) was named **First Place Winner** in the folk category in the 2008 Indie International Songwriting Contest and was honored as a Finalist in the USA Songwriting Competition.
